If you would like to participate in Wreaths Across America this year meet on Saturday, December 19 at the Bel Air Memorial Gardens in Bel Air, at **11:45 am**.

- We will participate in the ceremony honoring veterans who served in all branches of the armed forces. **Col. Aquila Hall Chapter SAR Color Guard will do a musket salute.**
- After the ceremony Bel Air American Legion Post 39 will distribute wreaths which we will place on the graves of veterans buried there. Post 39 will have marked the graves in advance to make this easier.
- Wreaths are supplied by Bel Air American Legion Post 39—**you do not need to bring or purchase a wreath.**
- If you wish to fund a wreath for Bel Air Memorial Gardens you may make a donation of **\$15.00** per wreath; deadline for the order is **December 10**. that veteran's name aloud and take a moment to thank them for their service to our country. It's a small act that goes a long way toward keeping the memory of our veterans alive.
